In 1994 Emma François obtained a Postgraduate Degree in Economic Anthropology, she then created her ready-to-wear label Sessùn in Marseille in 1995.

In contact with craftsmen in South America, she created a number of pieces, including a pullover in alpaca which drew interest from several boutiques. In 1999 she came to the attention of Maryline Bellieud-Vigouroux, the then President of the Institut Mode Méditerranée - IMM (Mediterranean Fashion Institute) who awarded her a prize. The IMM subsequently became the Maison Mode Méditerranée - MMM (Fashion School).
